### Reg: Minutes of the Steering Committee Meeting held on 14.05.2025

The quarterly meeting of the Steering Sub-Committee of SLBC was held virtually on 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2025 to fix up the agenda for the ensuing 168<sup>th</sup> SLBC meeting. The meeting was presided over by Shri Manas Dhar, Special Secretary & Director, Institutional Finance, Finance Dept., GoWB and witnessed the participation of distinguished representatives from various departments of GoWB, RBI, NABARD and all the major Banks. Notable attendees included Dr. Prabir Roy (Asstt Director, ARD, GoWB), Shri Hrishikesh Mudi (Spl Commissioner, Agriculture & Agriculture Marketing, GoWB), Smt Sarmishtha Dey (Secretary, Fishery, GoWB), Shri Sibabrata Pal (DGM, RBI), Shri Sunil Kumar Pandey (DGM, NABARD).

The session commenced with a cordial welcome by Shri Balbir Singh, General Manager & Convenor, SLBC West Bengal. In his address, Shri Singh provided a concise overview of the proposed agenda items intended for deliberation during the 168<sup>th</sup> SLBC meeting and encouraged all the participants to contribute their insightful perspectives and suggestions to ensure productive and impactful discussion.

The ensuing deliberations focused on key areas, culminating in the formulation of specific action points, which are hereby detailed for your kind attention:

- Suggestions by Shri Sibabrata Pal (DGM, RBI): It was proposed to include the following as agenda of the upcoming SLBC meeting:
  1. Collateral free agricultural loans upto Rs.2.00 lac and end-use verification of gold loans for agricultural
  2. Updation of banking outlet data pertaining of Unbanked Rural Centers in the RBI's CISBI portal,
  3. Credit to Minority Communities residing in Minority concentration Districts.
  4. SLBC Website – Standardization of information/data.

(Action point 1: SLBC West Bengal)

- Suggestions by Shri Manas Dhar (Special Secretary & Director, Institutional Finance, GoWB): It was proposed to include the onboarding of banks and Govt Line Departments in the Unified Lending Interface (ULI) portal as an agenda item.

(Action point 2: SLBC West Bengal)

All the points raised during the meeting were duly noted by SLBC, West Bengal for the purpose of ensuring diligent compliance. Member banks also concurred with the views and suggestions that emerged from the discussions.
