The Members of the SLBC Steering Committee

Re: Minutes of the Steering Committee meeting on 19.09.2024

The quarterly meeting of the Steering Sub-Committee of SLBC was held virtually on 19th September 2024 to fix up the agenda for the ensuing 165th SLBC meeting. The meeting was attended by Sri Manas Dhar, Special Secretary & Director, Institutional Finance, Sri Sibabrata Pal, DGM, RBI; Sri Amlan Dash, DGM, NABARD, representatives from various line departments of GoWB and representatives of major member banks.

The Meeting began with a warm welcome note delivered by Sri Shio Shankar Singh, General Manager, SLBC West Bengal. He apprised the house that the 165th SLBC Meeting for reviewing the business position of quarter ending on June' 2024 had been scheduled to be held on 30.09.2024. He briefly enumerated the proposed agenda items for the aforesaid SLBC meeting and invited the participants to give their valuable inputs/ suggestions for having a fruitful interaction on the proposed agenda points.

The major points of discussions along with the action points emerged during the Steering Committee Meeting are stated below:

- Sri Manas Dhar, Special Secretary & Director, Institutional Finance, Finance Dept., GoWB advised to merge agenda item no 3- Special SLBC Agenda on FI containing last three years comparison of progress under FI with agenda item no 18-Progress made under Financial Inclusion.
- Further, he advised to merge Agenda no- 10-PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSGMBY) with Agenda item no 21- Non-conventional renewable energy as sustainable alternative for affordable transportation.
- Sri Amlan Dash, DGM, NABARD suggested for inclusion of NPS Vatsalya in Agenda Items as DFS, GoI has given special focus under this newly launched scheme.
- Sri Manas Dhar advised to include this topic under Miscellaneous agenda item and for its further promotion he suggested to hold separate meeting along with member banks.
- Sri Sibabrata Pal, DGM, RBI suggested to include School Curriculum in Agenda Items.
- Sri Manas Dhar advised to add this topic under Agenda of Financial Inclusion.
- Sri Sibabrata Pal also requested to highlight the two adopted districts i.e- Purba Medinipur & Paschim Bardhaman under Agenda item- Expanding & Deepening of Digital Payment Ecosystem as these two districts are yet to achieve 100 % digitization within stipulated time period of June 2024.
- All the points were noted by SLBC West Bengal for ensuring compliance. Member banks also accepted the view/ suggestion emerged from the meeting.

After having fruitful interactions amongst the participants, the final Agenda Items as well as its sequence were finalized for discussion in the ensuing 165th SLBC meeting. The final Agenda items are as follows:
